The 80th anniversary of D-Day is on 6th June 2024. As part of the commemorations, beacons and lamplights of peace will be lit across the British Isles and other nations as we remember the blood that was shed and those who gave their lives for our freedom.

We believe that this is of huge spiritual significance. Many of us have dreamt, prayed and longed for revival fires across our nations and for Jesus, our light of the world, to be made known and for many, many more people to know and love Him. We're praying that as people hear the Church bells ring out in remembrance and as the fires and lights are seen, the Church and the nations will be awakened to the urgency of the times and what God is wanting to do.

In the 80-day lead up to the anniversary, starting on Monday 18th March, there will be pipers playing in different nations in recognition of the piper who played a significant role in D-Day. We feel strongly led to pray, fast and worship during the same 80 days and would love as many people as possible to join in from across the world.

Please pray, worship, fast, gather and be creative as you are led. We've created this guide to help us to pray together across different regions and nations. God of all the earth

Day 1 – Monday 18th March

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Lord, in this time of remembrance, help us to remember you as the Creator of all things.

Day 2 – Tuesday 19th March

Psalms 24:1 The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it

Lord, all is yours, and always has been, and we acknowledge You overall in both the good times and the bad.

Day 3 – Wednesday 20th March

Exodus 20:3 “You shall have no other gods before me.”

Lord, we bow before your Name and acknowledge that no other god or idol, including good things like freedom, comes before You. You are all-in-all.

MARCH



Day 4 – Thursday 21st March

James 1:17 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

Lord, you are the author of all that is good, in our individual lives and in the corporate life of our nation.

Day 5 – Friday 22nd March

Psalms 27:1 The Lord is my light and my salvation---whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life---of whom shall I be afraid?

Lord, you are our stronghold, teach us to cling to You through every season, and may a fearful Church become fearless and even fearsome to the enemy in the days ahead.

Darkness in the earth

Day 6 – Saturday 23rd March

2 Corinthians 4:4 The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

Lord, as we prepare to celebrate the victory of D-Day, we recognise the darkness that is again settling around us and we cry out to you for you Light to break through the darkness.

MARCH

Day 7 – Sunday 24th March

Daniel 2:21 He changes times and seasons; he deposes kings and raises up others. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning.

Lord, as we remember, we thank you that You are over all events, situations and earthly rulers, and we can take hope and comfort in this as we look at the growing darkness in our own time.

Day 8 – Monday 25th March

Psalms 18:28 You, Lord, keep my lamp burning; my God turns my darkness into light.

Lord, like the 'pea soup' fogs of the war years, where torches and lamps were needed to show the way in the darkness, may we Your people shine like stars in the darkness and lead many to You.

Day 9 – Tuesday 26th March

Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.

Lord, we remind ourselves that trust in You is a bedrock to stand on when all the world is shifting and shaking.

MARCH

Day 10 – Wednesday 27th March

Deuteronomy 6:5 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

Lord, we fix our eyes on You and allow this verse to soak deep into us, body, soul and spirit.

Day 11 – Thursday 28th March

Leviticus 19:18 Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against anyone among your people, but love your neighbour as yourself. I am the Lord.

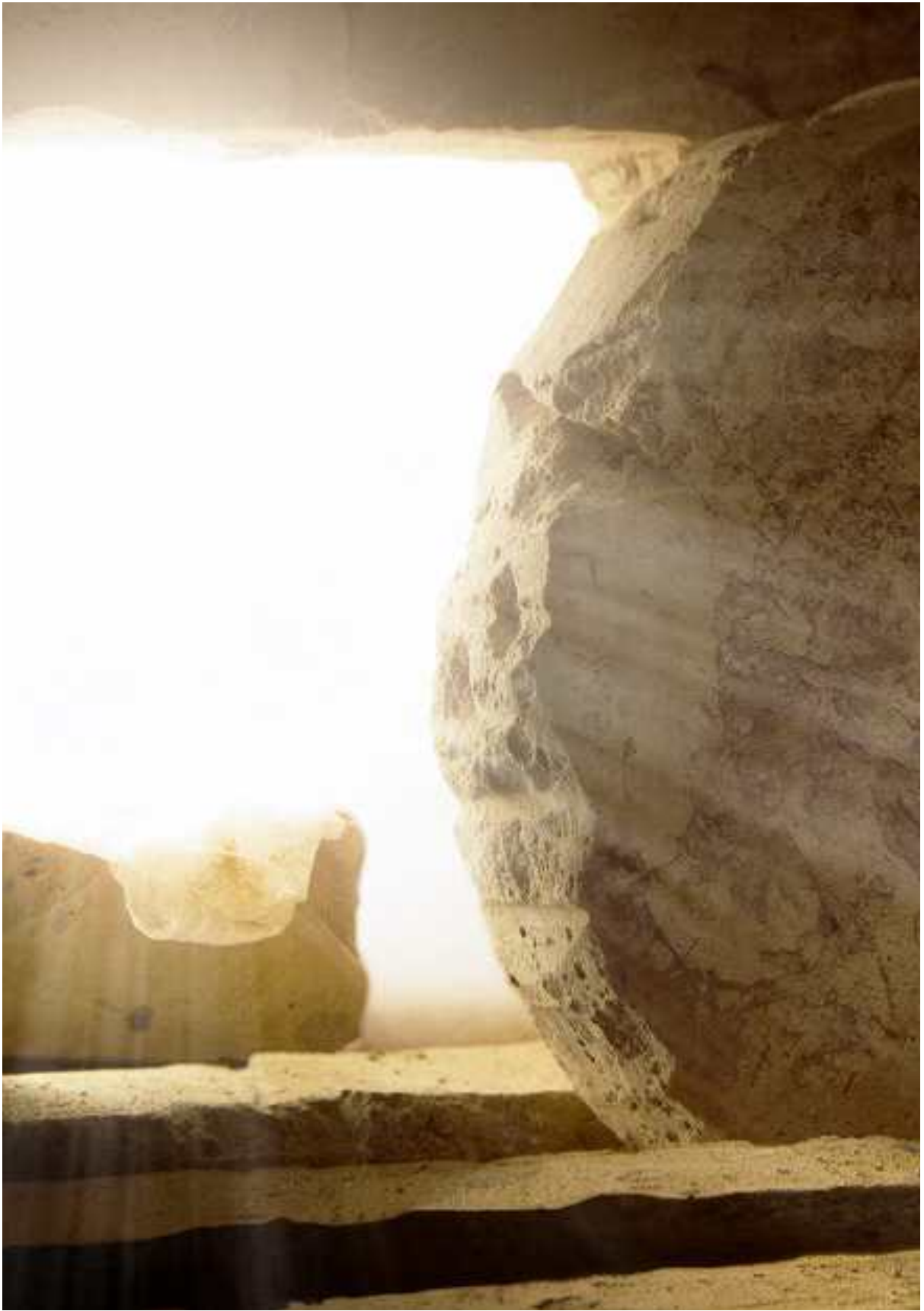
Lord, as we remember D-Day, we pray for reconciliation across borders and national divides, daring to believe that even the most deeply rooted hurts and conflicts might be overcome and overturned by Jesus our Prince of Peace.

Day 12 – Friday 29th March

Ephesians 5:15 Be very careful, then, how you live---not as unwise but as wise.

As information and disinformation swirls about us, we fix our eyes and our hearts on You. Guide us in Your ways of wisdom.

Day 13 – Saturday 30th March

Psalm 119:130 The unfolding of your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple.

Father, grant us new power, by the Spirit of God, to understand and apply Your word.

Light in the darkness: Sunrise

Day 14 – Sunday 31st March

John 1:5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

When the darkness is all around us, we remember this word.

Day 15 – Monday 1st April

John 1:9 The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world.

Lord, reflecting on D-Day and the darkness of the war years, we acknowledge the True Light was in the world then, and He is in the world now, and we give you thanks.

APRIL

Day 16 – Tuesday 2nd April

Isaiah 60:1 “Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you.

Lord, this was so true during the war years, and it is so true now in a darkening world, and we thank you and praise you for the light and glory of Jesus.

Day 17 – Wednesday 3rd April

John 12:46 I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness.

Lord God, help us to always remember – and to always declare – that Jesus is the light of the world.

Day 18 – Thursday 4th April

Romans 13:12 The night is nearly over; the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armour of light.

Lord, in these days of turmoil and confusion, let us be shaped by Jesus, the light within us, and not cowed by the darkness around us.

God's rescue plan

Day 19 – Friday 5th April

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Lord God, clothe us, Your people, in humility as we recognise our need of grace and mercy. Help us always to extend the same grace and mercy to others so that they might find hope and salvation in Jesus.

Day 20 – Saturday 6th April

Romans 3:24 and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

Lord God, give us new wisdom to understand the magnificence of Your mercy and a new boldness to declare this good news about Jesus Christ to all people at all times as You lead us by Your Spirit.

Day 21 – Sunday 7th April

1 John 1:5 This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.

Lord God, let us never be in any doubt as to the wonderful purity and righteousness of Your heart and character. Forgive us where we have seen or spoken of You in any way which misrepresents Your goodness and lovingkindness.

Day 22 – Monday 8th April

APRIL

John 12:36 Believe in the light while you have the light, so that you may become children of light. When he had finished speaking, Jesus left and hid himself from them.

Lord God, let us more and more visibly walk and talk as children of Your light.

Day 23 – Tuesday 9th April

Ephesians 5:8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light...

Lord, we cry out for Your mercy on Europe as darkness is increasing, knowing that You can rescue all out of the darkness.

Day 24 – Wednesday 10th April

Psalms 32:1 Blessed is the one whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.

Lord, we thank you for the various ministries of reconciliation that have sprung up since World War Two. We pray for them to continue to be rooted and grounded in You.

APRIL

Day 25 – Thursday 11th April

Job 33:28 God has delivered me from going down to the pit, and I shall live to enjoy the light of life.

Lord, let us grasp again the reality of our salvation. You have saved us from such a terrible fate, and into such glorious life.

Day 26 – Friday 12th April

Genesis 1:3 And God said, “Let there be light”, and there was light

Father God, help us to understand Your eternal plan. This one command created physical light, but also spoke of the coming of Jesus and the raising of sons and daughters who would carry His light through every generation until He returns.

Day 27 – Saturday 13th April

Song of Songs 8:7 Many waters cannot quench love; rivers cannot sweep it away. If one were to give all the wealth of one's house for love, it would be utterly scorned.

Lord God, give us a new understanding of the supremacy and ultimate authority of love, which can never be overcome.

APRIL



Sacrifice: the blood of Jesus

Day 28 – Sunday 14th April

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Lord God, give us a new understanding of Your story, the great love You have for people and the great price You paid to fulfil that love and longing in Your heart. Help us today to make sure that we love as You love, and love those You love, so that we are prepared to give our lives for them and for You.

Day 29 – Monday 15th April

Hebrews 12:24 [*you have come*] to Jesus the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.

Lord God, even as we remember the blood of those who gave their lives on D-Day and during the long weeks, months and years of conflict that unfolded up to that point, we ask You for fresh grace to understand the cleansing power and righteousness that has been released through Your own precious blood.

APRIL

Day 30 – Tuesday 16th April

John 15:13 Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.

Lord, as we remember all those who fought for freedom, selflessly laying their lives down for the sake of future generations, we ask You that this same selflessness might be found in us and that we would learn from today to love well and live truly for the benefit of those around us.

Day 31 – Wednesday 17th April

1 John 4:10 This is love; not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

Father, give us a new security and certainty in the richness and power of Your love for us.

Day 32 – Thursday 18th April

Philippians 1:21 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.

Lord, we remember the sacrifice of those who fought in D-Day, and acknowledge we are all called to ultimate sacrifice in Christ and pray for a deep revelation of this, for Your glory.

Repentance

Day 33 – Friday 19th April

Acts 3:19 Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord.

Lord God, we pray today that a wave of national repentance might wash over this nation and all the nations of the earth.

Day 34 – Saturday 20th April

Isaiah 30:15 This is what the Sovereign Lord, the Holy One of Israel, says: “In repentance and rest is your salvation, in quietness and trust is your strength, but you would have none of it”.

Lord God, forgive us any stubbornness, and grant us a new tenderness of heart so that we might turn to You and be saved.

Day 35 – Sunday 21st April

1 John 1:9 But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.

Father God, bring each of us in Your Church to a deeper understanding of repentance, mercy and holiness.

APRIL

Day 36 – Monday 22nd April

James 4:8 Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world.

Father God, we pray again for the lost to be brought in, for harvest across the nation and nations, and for Jesus, the Lamb of God, to receive the fullness of the reward for His sufferings in this generation.

Day 37 – Tuesday 23rd April

Luke 4:31-32 Jesus answered them, “Healthy people don’t need a doctor—sick people do. I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners and need to repent”.

Father God, we continue to pray for mercy and for salvation. Give us the longing of Your heart for the lost, so that we might truly give ourselves to this great commission.

Day 38 – Wednesday 24th April

Isaiah 55:7 Let the wicked change their ways and banish the very thought of doing wrong. Let them turn to the Lord that he may have mercy on them. Yes, turn to our God, for he will forgive generously.

Lord God, we again cry out to You – ‘Give us Your heart for the lost!’

Day 38 – Thursday 25th April

APRIL

Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

Lord God, return a holy and healthy fear of the Lord to Your Church, so that we can know You, receive understanding, and stand in the day of trouble.

Preparation: Consecration of our hearts

Day 39 – Friday 26th April

Isaiah 40:3 A voice of one calling: “In the wilderness prepare the way for the Lord ; make straight in the desert a highway for our God.”

Lord, we lift our hearts to you knowing that You always prepare a way to enter into our individual and corporate lives. May more and more people hear your Voice calling.

Day 40 – Saturday 27th April

Psalms 24:9 Lift up your heads, you gates; lift them up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in.

Lord God, help us to pray in power today that every door and gate of power would be opened to the gospel and to our King of glory, Jesus Christ.

APRIL

Day 41 – Sunday 28th April

Isaiah 1:18 “Come now, let us settle the matter,” says the Lord. “Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.

Lord, we thank you that you have settled the matter in and through Jesus, forgiving all our sin and adopting us into the household of God.

Day 42 – Monday 29th April

Joshua 3:5 Joshua told the people, “Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do amazing things among you.”

Lord God, God of the impossible, may there be a new and growing sense of expectation amongst Your people of the great things You are planning to do in our generation and beyond.

Day 43 – Tuesday 30th April

1 John 3:1 See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him...

Lord God, even as we remember and rejoice in the freedoms that were won for us by those who gave everything in the great wars, help us to remember and rejoice in the ultimate freedom we have received in Jesus to be children of God forever.

APRIL

Day 44 – Wednesday 1st May

Isaiah 55:6 Seek the Lord while he may be found; call on him while he is near.

Lord God, help us to hear and to sound this trumpet of trumpets – the call to seek Your face while we can, and before it is too late.

Day 45 – Thursday 2nd May

Romans 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

Lord, let our hearts grasp the deepness and richness of your love, and in knowing who we are in you through Your love, we would impact the world for your glory, both in hidden and noticeable ways.

Standing

Day 46 – Friday 3rd May

Joshua 1:9 “Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.”

Lord God Almighty, visit Your Church with holiness and courage like never before.

Day 47 – Saturday 4th May

MAY

John 7:38 “Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them.”

Lord God, give us a new understanding of this mystery, that the fullness of Your power and might, the fullness of Your heart and Spirit, not only lives within us but pours out of us as we walk with You.

Day 48 – Sunday 5th May

1 Corinthians 6:17 But whoever is united with the Lord is one with him in spirit.

Lord God, give us a new and deeper understanding of this mystery - we are not what we were, but in Christ Jesus have been joined to you forever.

Day 49 – Monday 6th May

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

Lord God, we pray that there might once again be a holy distinction on Your people, set apart for Your plans and purposes in the earth and carrying Your love and power to a poor and needy generation.

MAY

Day 50 – Tuesday 7th May

Ephesians 4:4 There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called.

Lord God, may there be true and miraculous unity amongst Your people, both now and forevermore.

Day 51 – Wednesday 8th May

Ephesians 1:22 And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the Church

Hallelujah for the Church! Lord God, give us a fresh understanding of the authority and power You have released for Your people to steward in all the earth.

Day 52 – Thursday 9th May

Matthew 5:16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

Father, may the motivation for our good deeds always be love for you and love for others, but may much life and healing come from our service, and much glory to Your name.

MAY

Day 53 – Friday 10th May

Deuteronomy 8:11 Be careful that you do not forget the Lord your God, failing to observe his commands, his laws and his decrees that I am giving you this day.

Lord even as we remember the heroism of men and women, may we never forget the glorious grace and kindness of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Day 54 – Saturday 11th May

Ephesians 6:13 Therefore put on the full armour of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.

Father, give us a new and deeper understanding of spiritual warfare at every level, and teach us again the importance of simply standing for You, for truth, for the Church and for the lost.

Day 55 – Sunday 12th May

Numbers 11:29 But Moses replied, “Are you jealous for my sake? I wish that all the Lord's people were prophets and that the Lord would put his Spirit on them!”

Lord God, give us this same heart – that we would long for every believer to be full of the Spirit of God.

MAY

Day 56 – Monday 13th May

Matthew 6:22 “The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are healthy, your whole body will be full of light.”

Lord God, in a world of increasing darkness and debauchery, help us to keep our eyes clean and fixed on You.

Day 57 – Tuesday 14th May

1 Thessalonians 5:5 You are all children of the light and children of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness.

Lord God, give us a new distaste for the things that displease and dishonour You, and a new appetite for the bread of life and living water.

Peace

Day 58 – Wednesday 15th May

Psalm 4:8 In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, LORD, make me dwell in safety.

Father, may there be a national and even an international recognition that You alone can be trusted.

Day 59 – Thursday 16th May

MAY

John 14:27 “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.”

Father, we pray that the Church would once again become a haven and a power to stand against all forms of mental illness and anguish.

Day 60 – Friday 17th May

Isaiah 26:3 You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.

*Lord God, forgive us for the many ways we have become distracted.
Lord God, forge in us, Your people, an undivided heart.*

Day 61 – Saturday 18th May

2 Thessalonians 3:16 Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times and in every way. The Lord be with all of you.

Lord God, grant Your Church, Your people, astonishing peace in the days ahead so that we can be a source of peace to others in the world.

MAY

Day 62 – Sunday 19th May

Colossians 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.

Lord God, forgive us for the many ways we have allowed division and self-interest to clog up the flow of Your love and Your Spirit in Your Church. Lord God, please help each of us to set this right.

Day 63 – Monday 20th May

Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Lord, we echo this prayer of Paul's, for ourselves, for the Church, for the nation, and the nations.

Day 64 – Tuesday 21st May

1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you.

Father, help us to trust that You really do know us and care for us.

MAY

Day 65 – Wednesday 22nd May

John 16:33 “I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

Lord Jesus, help us to never be overwhelmed by the trouble you said would come, but instead help us as Your people to demonstrate true courage and self-sacrifice in our service to God and people.

Freedom

Day 66 – Thursday 23rd May

2 Corinthians 3:17 Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.

Lord God, please pour out Your Spirit in the Church, in the nation and in the nations, to a degree which we have never seen or heard of before. All for Your glory, for freedom and for the saving of many lives.

Day 67 – Friday 24th May

John 8:36 So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

Lord God, we pray for true freedom and deliverance to be released across the whole family of believers, so that we might heal and release others in turn.

MAY

Day 68 – Saturday 25th May

1 Corinthians 6:12 “I have the right to do anything,” you say—but not everything is beneficial. “I have the right to do anything”—but I will not be mastered by anything.

Lord God, forgive us wherever and whenever we have squandered the incredible freedom that you and others have won for us. Help us to be wiser with our time.

Day 69 – Sunday 26th May

Galatians 5:13 You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

Lord God have mercy on us, as You deal with all manner of secret and hidden sins in Your Church.

Day 70 – Monday 27th May

Galatians 5:1 It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.

Father, we ask for grace in this generation to completely shun and overcome the religious and political spirits that are so rife in these days.

MAY

Day 71 – Tuesday 28th May

Psalm 119:45 I will walk about in freedom, for I have sought out your precepts.

Father, teach us the fullness of salvation that is ours. Let us know like never before that we are free to serve You and others in power when we submit to Your truth and precepts.

Day 72 – Wednesday 29th May

1 Peter 2:16 Live as free people, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil; live as God's slaves.

Father God, forgive us – as individuals, as a Church and as the nation - for the many ways in which we have hurt and exploited others, often hiding behind some form of justification.

Day 73 – Thursday 30th May

Romans 8:21 ...that the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom and glory of the children of God.

Lord God, please give us understanding of how we are to bring about renewal and reformation in the earth as we prepare for Your return.

MAY



No more death

Day 74 – Friday 31st May

Revelation 19:11 I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice He judges and wages war.

Lord, thank You that You have waged war against death and sin, and You have won. Help us to join you in the fight so that this same victory may be won in our generation.

Day 75 – Saturday 1st June

Revelation 21:4 He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.

As we remember both the victory and the incredible challenge and loss of life on D-Day, we are so grateful that we can look forward to a day when all sadness, grief, pain and sorrow will be removed forever.

Day 76 – Sunday 2nd June

Revelation 20:11 Then I saw a great white throne and Him who was seated on it. The earth and the heavens fled from his presence, and there was no place for them.

Lord God, please give us Your people a deeper understanding of Your sovereignty over world events, and the mercy, grace and severity of the coming judgement.

JUNE

Day 77 – Monday 3rd June

Revelation 22:12 “Look, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to each person according to what they have done.”

Father, help us, by Your Spirit, Your word and Your grace, to live out on earth the lives of love, sacrifice and surrender that You have prepared for us.

Day 78 – Tuesday 4th June

Revelation 22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” And let the one who hears say, “Come!” Let the one who is thirsty come; and let the one who wishes take the free gift of the water of life.

Lord God, birth a new longing in our hearts so that we would truly cry, with the Spirit of God, “Come Lord Jesus!”

Day 79 – Wednesday 5th June

Revelation 22:20 He who testifies to these things says, “Yes, I am coming soon.” Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.

Lord God, give us fresh faith and anticipation of the nearness of Your coming, and the victory and joy of the age to come which You will usher in.

JUNE

Day 80 – Thursday 6th June

Revelation 22:21 The grace of the Lord Jesus be with God's people.
Amen.

Lord God, as the nations rage and the people plot in vain, would You help us to trust – like never before – in Your grace, Your mercy, Your love, Your truth, Your guidance and Your protection, in Jesus' name.

A final word, regarding some astonishing prophetic paintings:

Artist Julie Ann Scott has painted a series of nine prophetic paintings of World War Two. It is her strong belief that through them God has a message for the United Kingdom.
